Weiland ZX Zirconia is a more cost-effective zirconia restoration, while Opalite is virtually unbreakable and perfect for demanding posterior cases.

Which are the best restoration materials for bruxers and grinders?

Opalite restorations are milled from zirconia using CAD/CAM tehcnology. They exhibit an exceptional flexural strength of 1100mPa and are virtually unbreakable, making them ideal for posterior cases and patients with bruxing sn grinding issues. Becuase Opalite is monolithic it requires much less preparation space than traditional crowns and it is far more aesthetic than traditional PFM restorations.

Which are the best restoration materials for aesthetically demanding cases?

For cases which require a high level of aesthetics (particularly anterior restorations) we recommend one of our premium crown and bridge options: premium PFM, 3M ESPE Lava or pressed Ivoclar e.Max.
